### Guidelines for submitting abstracts

- Title:** The title should be succinct, informative and relevant.
- Sub-theme:** All authors should specify the sub-theme the paper is addressing
- Authorship:** All abstracts should contain the name/s, institution, and current e-mail address/es of contributing author/s
- Key Aspects:** Abstracts should be a maximum of 300 words. They should include: title, author, contact details, 4 key words.
- Language:** All abstracts should be in English
- Font:** Arial 12 using 1.5 spacing.
